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#### Homework Policy

The school policy for homework was developed and agreed by the whole staff in consultation with parents and pupils and has the full agreement of the Governing Body.

## Our aim for homework at Bucklesham

- Ensure consistency of approach throughout the school.
- To use homework as a tool to help to continue to raise standards of attainment.
- Improve the quality of the learning experience offered to pupils beyond the classroom environment.
- Provide opportunities for parents, children and the school to work together in partnership in relation to children's learning.
- Encourage pupils and their parents to share and enjoy learning experiences.
- Reinforce work covered in class by providing further opportunities for the individual pupil.
- To practise or consolidate basic skills and knowledge, especially in Numeracy and Literacy.
- Encourage children to develop the responsibility, confidence and selfdiscipline needed to study independently.
- To prepare Year 6 pupils for the transfer to secondary school

# Homework in EYFS, KS1 and KS2

Home learning is an important part of all pupil's education. We also understand that some weeks and weekends are busier and more demanding than others, which is why we have introduced the points system of homework. This system has been designed to encourage children to manage their workload within a given time frame (6 weeks), while taking the pressure off children and their families to ensure a certain amount of homework is completed and returned each week.

Each half term every child must earn a <u>minimum of 10 points</u> through the homework tasks they complete. Parents are encouraged to support their child to work towards these required points by choosing from any of the tasks. These tasks include children's reading which we encourage the parents to do with their child as often as possible – at least 4/5 times a week.

Children in Reception will commence homework in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of the Autumn Term.
