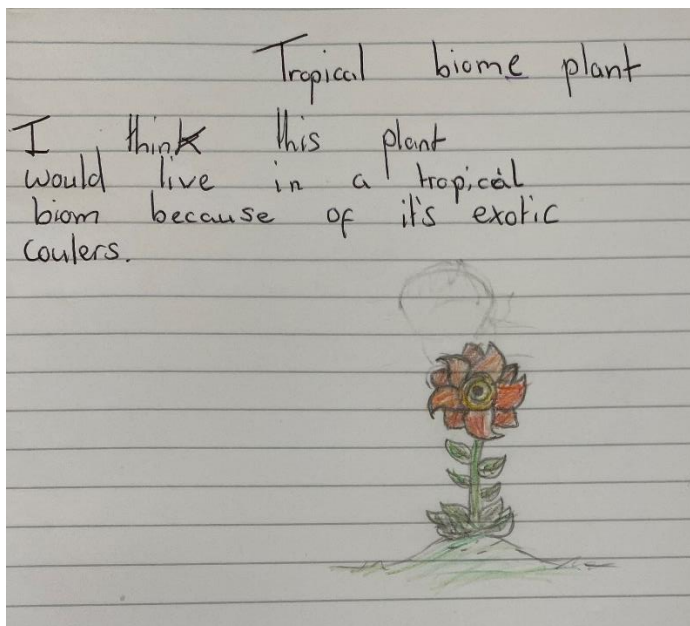
Celebration Assembly
