<p>Can you go on a walk and find 10 autumnal items? (such as conkers, acorns, pinecones, orange/brown/red leaves). Can you sort these items into various different groups? How many different groups could you create? Can you make a pattern using some/all of your items? Take a picture of draw your results for both tasks!</p> <p>VALUE: 5 points</p>		<p>Can you set a timer and see how many of each of these tricky words you can write correctly in 1 minute?
