Seasonal - VALUE: 3 POINTS

Go for a walk with a grown up and look for signs of spring. Talk about what you can see. Can you spot any flowers growing? What is the weather like? Did you see any animals? You could take a photo or draw a picture of what you see on your spring walk. Then using your sound mat label your picture/drawing.

COMPULSORY:

Read daily



Health & Hygiene - VALUE: 2 POINTS

Make a chart to show how many times you are brushing your teeth each week. You could add each time you brush your teeth on with a tick, sticker or stamp. You could set a timer or think of a song that lasts 2 minutes to help you. (There may be a prize for the people who have brushed them the most!)

Phonics/Writing - VALUE: 5 POINTS

Choose a *minimum* of 3 tricky words to write *at least* 3 different sentences. You could write about something you did at the weekend, a favourite toy or book, whatever you like. Remember your capital letters, finger spaces, full stops and to check your sentences after!

Use the sound mats to help you.

Tricky word examples: into, push, was, put, pull, full, you

Maths - VALUE: 5 POINTS

Can you recall your number bonds to 5? Practice writing them down using number sentences. *Such as* $0+5=5$, $1+4=5$, $2+3=5$. Can you also have a go at the number bonds to 10? Use your fingers to help you. E.g. "Zero and how many makes ten? Put zero fingers down, how many do you have left? 10! So, zero and ten equals ten..." See if you can write the number sentences for these too! *Such as* $0+10=10$, $1+9=10$...

Teachers note:

Home learning is an important part of your child's education. We also understand that some weeks and weekends are busier than others, which is why we are using a points system for homework. This system has been designed to allow a more manageable workload over a period of time.

Each half term your child must earn a **minimum of 10 points** through the homework tasks they complete. They can choose from any of the tasks above to reach those points. You can either do the tasks in the homework book or upload pictures on class dojo (or a mixture of the two).
