## As a school

We will do our best to:

- › Support your child's wellbeing and safety by providing a safe, supportive and caring environment
- › Develop positive attitudes, responsibility and relationships, establishing fairness and equality, so every individual's contribution to the school community is valued and their self-esteem is developed
- › Help and encourage your child to reach their full potential, celebrating effort and achievement
- › Provide a broad and balanced curriculum that caters for all children, and inspires them to be active participants, including when delivered remotely
- › Develop independence through the provision of well-resourced and accessible learning environments
- › Set and reinforce boundaries and promote high standards of behaviour, so children feel able to make choices in learning and behaviour, within a safe and secure environment
- › Offer opportunities for parents and carers to get involved in school life
- › Communicate between home and school through weekly emails, Class Dojo, ParentMail and the school website
- › Respond to communications from parents in a timely manner, following school policies
- › Provide updates on your child's progress and guidance on how to support at home
- › Set homework in line with national guidelines and school policy
- › Contact you if there is a concern about attendance, punctuality, work or behaviour

## Parents/carers

I will do my best to:


- › Make sure my child attends school regularly and on time, before 8:50am. I will notify the school before 9:20am if my child will be absent
- › Avoid taking holidays in term time
- › Park outside school safely and considerately taking into account other parent/child safety and will ensure I allow myself the appropriate time to do so
- › Make sure my child is dressed in the correct uniform and brings their PE kit to school where necessary, following the school's policy
- › Support the school to make sure my child maintains a consistently high standard of behaviour

- Encourage my child to try their best so they can reach their full potential
  - Communicate to the school any concerns that I have about my child that may affect their behaviour in school or ability to learn
  - Make sure communication with the school is respectful, and that I make every reasonable effort to address my communications to the appropriate member of staff
  - Understand that I should communicate with staff during core school hours, and although they may at times respond outside of those hours, I can't always expect that
  - Make sure that my child completes their homework on time, and raise any issues that my child has with their teachers
  - Read and follow the school's policies
  - Treat all members of the school community with care and respect
  - Engage in parent meetings and work together with the school in order to achieve the best outcomes for my child
  - Read all communications sent home by the school and respond where necessary
