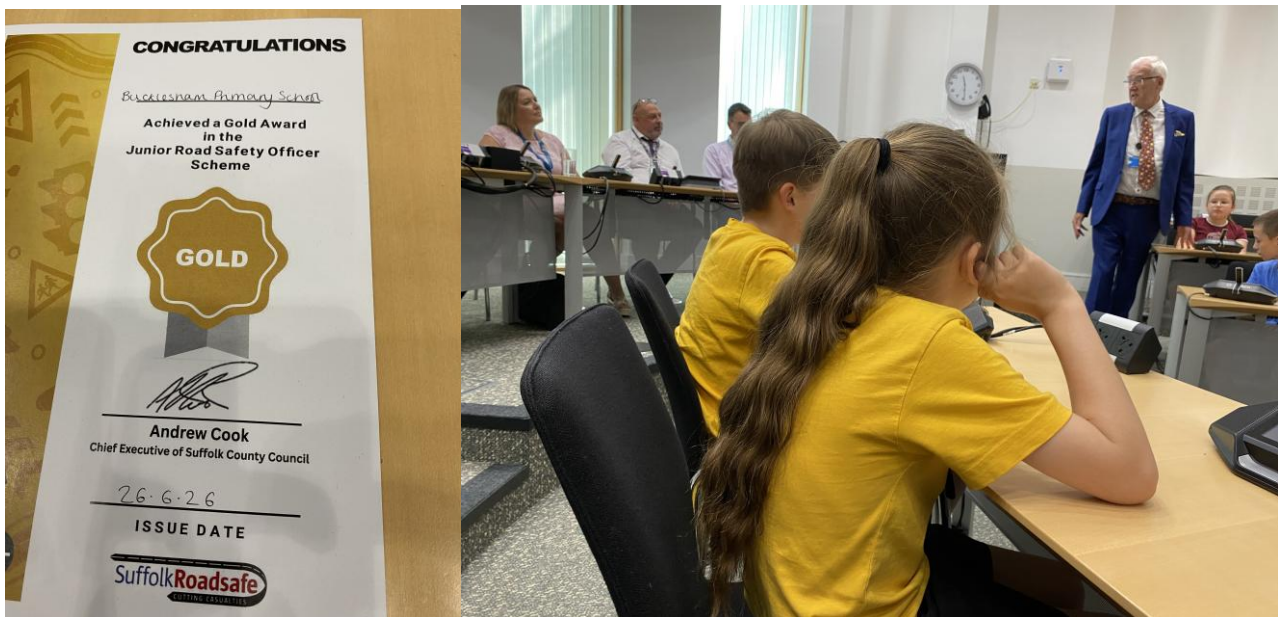
Limited parking is available, so walking to the event is encouraged for ease and eco reasons.
